RE: Affordable Care Act (aka, Health Care Reform)

and Health Insurance Marketplace

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act ("ACA") was signed into law on March 23, 2010.

Below is a list of a few of the mandates under the ACA:

- Dependent coverage up to age 26;
- Elimination of lifetime limits on essential health benefits:
- No cost sharing for Preventive Health Services:
- The cost of employer health plans are reported on employee W-2 forms (beginning with the 2012 year);
- Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) are available to employees to compare health plan offerings.

Another mandate of the Affordable Care Act requires employers to share information about the new "Health Insurance Marketplace" with employees annually. Attached is a notice from the U.S. Department of Labor with general information about the Health Insurance Marketplace. In California, the Health Insurance Marketplace is called "Covered California". Another provision of the ACA that became effective January 1, 2014 is the "Individual Mandate". Individuals must obtain minimum essential health coverage or be subject to a penalty.
