Do You Need Assistance with Child Care Payments?

Children's Home Society of California (CHS) offers a Child Care Payment Program which may be able to help you with child care payments.



Our subsidized child care program provides help paying for child care for income eligible families. Parents are able to choose a child care provider that meets the needs of their family.

Families may be eligible if parents meet income requirements and has one or more qualifying need for services:

- are working or attending school, or
- are seeking employment, or
- the child is at risk of abuse or neglect (requires referral)

Completion of an Eligibility Questionnaire (EQ) begins the process to determine your eligibility. Eligibility is based on your gross monthly income and family size. New enrollment is based on availability of funds.
