The Advanced Culinary Arts/Hospitality Management program prepares students for careers in the rapidly expanding food service and hospitality industry. Emphasis is placed on learning by hands-on execution. Students learn to prepare food in restaurant and catering type settings. Instruction includes such topics as: kitchen terminology, culinary nutrition, food sanitation, menu production, food pairing, recipe analysis, meat identification, product knowledge, demonstration of skills and much more. In addition to this, students operate a fully themed mobile kitchen in an entrepreneurial model.

What is ROP?

The Tri-County Regional Occupational Program (ROP) offers career technical training courses to high school students and adults in Colusa, Sutter, and Yuba Counties. These courses provide training in many different occupations and are geared to entry-level employment, preparation for advanced training, or retraining. Additional information about ROP courses is available at career centers and counseling offices in participating districts.

Why Take an ROP Course?

Whether you plan to work full-time after graduation or work part-time and continue in school, an ROP course will teach you skills to get and keep a worthwhile job. It will also give you high school credit while you are learning. When you complete a course, you will receive a certificate of proficiency that lists the skills that you have gained. This certificate is widely recognized by the business community and is a valuable job-seeking tool.

Who is Eligible?

If you are in 11th or 12th grade and live in a school district that participates in ROP, you are eligible whether you are a regularly enrolled student or not. This includes adults, private school students, charter school students, students on independent study, and students with disabilities.
